- The Coalition started in early 2012 with a Stakeholders meeting and presentation given by the founder of Project Lazarus-Wilkes County, Fred Brason III.
- The Coalition focuses on reducing Prescription Drug Misuse and Abuse and Overdose Deaths in Iredell County.
- Meetings take place on the first Monday of every other month. Next meeting is Monday, May 2nd, 2016 at 11am located at the Iredell County Health Department.
- DAFI-PL Coalition has raised awareness in Iredell County by participating in numerous presentations, community forums, trainings, health fairs, festivals and events.
- The coalition has also been involved in helping get first responders equipped with Naloxone Kits, an opioid reversal medication.

The Message

Safe Use: Take medications only as prescribed by your doctor and NEVER SHARE!

Safe Storage: Store your medications in a secure location, preferably locked up so children, young adults and others will not be able to access them.

Safe Disposal: Dispose medications that are unused or expired at the local permanent drop box locations and drug take backs.

Assessment

What We Know About Unintentional Medication and Drug Overdose In Iredell County

- 2008-2014: **159** Overdose Deaths, **26** were 12-25 years old
- 2008-2014: **495** Hospitalizations, **33** were 12-25 years old
- 2008-2014: **1050** Emergency Department Visits, **164** were 12-25 year old
- Most of these ER visits involved Benzodiazepines, Heroin, Opiates, Tranquilizers, Sedatives, Stimulants, and Other Drugs

Sustainability
