REGISTRY STAFF WILL:

- Support you and answer questions
- Schedule an intake phone appointment for the Registry of Unmet Needs for the Innovations Waiver and other I/DD services
- Assist and answer questions about necessary documents
- Assist with connection to a provider if state funds are available
- Place you or your family member on the State Funded Waitlist and/or Registry of Unmet Needs if eligible

Priority population for state funding is for those 18 to -21 years old.

A WALK-IN CENTER OR PROVIDER AGENCY WILL:

- Support you and answer questions
- Complete a Comprehensive Clinical Assessment (CCA) to identify needed treatment
- Assist with the next steps based on your needs

Priority populations for state funding: IV drug users and pregnant women.
